1. Call to Order.

a. Fillmore Township Planning Commission February 3, 2025 Minutes.

Fillmore Township Planning Commission Minutes of February 3, 2025, Item #5, Paragraph 2;

A Motion was brought by Elaine Mokma and 2nd by Bob Yonker to approve the request of the Fillmore Township Planning Commission to the Township Board to consider asking P.C.I. to review Chapter 21 of the Fillmore Township Zoning Ordinance, specifically to limit the percentage of total acre area allowed for manufactured homes. Also, if common open space may be used as storm water detention.

Additional reviewing other chapters in the Zoning Ordinance and offer advice for possible amendments. Supervisor Yonker to notify P.C.I.
